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This month's white wine recommendations

Chardonnay Guinevere Boot Hill Gusbourne 2020

Elegant and complex, this is a citrus driven wine with creamy and lightly toasted notes. Baked apple and pear, with warming spices shine through. A wonderful example of a still English wine.

Bin 237: £90Type: Full-bodiedGrape: Chardonnay

Qualitätswein Trocken Sybille Kuntz 2021

Organic wine certified; the grapes are picked in the first week of harvest. Maceration takes place in Stainless steel tanks and is fermented in acacia wood barrels. The taste is balanced and persistent between crisp green fruits, lime, floral notes, and lot of minerality with flint at the beginning.

Kin Semillon Alkina 2022

Organic, biodynamic, and vegan wine certified. The process is two fermentations: one larger fermentation in concrete with 10% whole berries and 10% whole bunches; the second on full skins (of which 40% whole bunch) in stainless steel. The taste is balanced between Waxy and textural floral notes and exotic spice aromas.

37 Gemischter Satz Ingrid Groiss 2022

This wine Bursts forth with flavors of crisp, tart Apple, fresh green pear, and ripe yet zesty citrus. There is an innate lightness and lovely depth, making it unforced, honest, and utterly refreshing. It dances on the palate with fresh-faced authenticity, leaving you wanting more.

5 Kalogeri Malagouzia Papagiannakos 2023

Is a Greek white wine made from the indigenous and increasingly fashionable Malagouzia grape, the grapes are sourced from 5 blocks of Malagouzia, harvested by hand in mid-August. The wine has lifted white peach, apricot, and white blossom aromas. It is broad with stone fruit and mandarin oil characters, and ripe, zesty, and fresh lemon acidity. It is fresh and textural with good length.

This month's red wine recommendations

'Estaladina' Mengoba 2021

Flavours of crushed red berries and wildflowers float across a lacy palate that strikes excellent tension between crisp acidity and light, tender tannins. It finishes with tangy-berry deliciousness and impressive persistence.

Monthélie Domaine Louis Jadot 2012

A well-known winery founded in 1859. The wine is fruity with developing red fruits and cherries aromas. It is well-structured with good tannins, powerful yet still delicate.

157 Old Quarter Alkina Kin 2020

Organic and biodynamic certified. Dark cherry, red liquorice, and exotic spice aromas with oak in the background. The palate is taking a distinctly savoury turn into tobacco and dusty, baked earth flavours over brooding mulberry.

6 Erythros Papagiannakos 2021

Is a Greek red wine made from a blend of the indigenous Agiorgitiko grape and Cabernet Sauvignon. The wine has ripe dark fruit aromas with a hint of spice. It has rich bramble fruit characters, notes of blackcurrant pastille, and is finely structured with well-integrated French oak. It also has fine tannins, a light savoury note, and a twist of liquorice on the finish. Bin 6: £75 Type: Full-bodied Grape: Blend of 70% of Agiorgitiko 20% Cabernet Sauvignon

France - Bordeaux Right and Left Bank

Pv6 St-Estèphe Château Lafon Rochet 2016 Château Lafon-Rochet is a 4ème Cru Classé St-Estèphe estate that has been owned by the Tesseron family since 1959. The notes are rich in black pepper and tobacco, well-balanced with a lovely cassis note shining through. **Type:** Full-bodied Grape: Blend Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot and Cabernet Franc

Pv2 Chateau Tertre Roteboeuf 2012

Château du Tertre is a 5ème Cru Classé situated in the Margaux commune. The notes deliver a good intensity of black plums, kirsch, and black raspberry, plus hints of dried Provence herbs, tobacco leaf and cedar. **Type:** Medium-bodied Grape: Blend Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Cabernet Franc

Pv7 Château Lynch Bages 2001

exhibits aromas of tapenade, bay leaf, liquorice, red and black currants, damp earth and new saddle leather. Atypically elegant and charming for a Lynch Bages with soft, fully resolved tannin and a moderately long finish.

Type: Medium-bodied Grape: Blend 78% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc, 2% Petit Verdot

418 St-Julien Château Leoville Barton 2007

Château Leoville Barton Is a zeme Cru Classé. The palates reveal notes of ripe cassis, raspberry, and notes of berries. The complexity develops with fine touches of tonka bean, sweet spices, and warm spices. **Type:** Full-bodied Grape: Blend Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc

Pv5 St-Julien Château Ducru Beaucaillou 2016

Château Ducru Beaucaillou is one of the standout wines from this vintage. The palate gives a firm backbone cloaked in layers of black fruit. The new oak is more present.

Pv1 Margaux Château Rauzan-Segla 2010

Château Rauzan-Segla is a 2eme Cru Classé and the estate expresses the world-renowned qualities of the Margaux terroir. On the palate it expresses notes of ripe and fresh wild berries combined with touches of graphite. **Type:** Full-bodied Grape: Blend Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot

406 St-Emilion Château Troplong Mondot 2015

Château Troplong Mondot is a 1er Grand Cru Classé. The Chateau boasts one of the largest estates in the St-Emilion appellation. Pure and bright, the nose gives off notes of ripe fruit, cherry, blackcurrant, and spices. Type: Full-bodied Grape: Blend Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc

Pv3 Les Forts de Latour Château Latour 2005

Les Forts de Latour is the second wine of First Growth Château Latour. The notes we can find cassis, pencil shavings, hints of tobacco. Full-bodied, with refined, silky tannins and a long finish. **Type:** Full-bodied Grape: Blend Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc

Pv8 St-Estèphe Château Montrose 2001

Château Montrose is one of the leading wine properties of St-Estèphe and produces the longest-lived wines in the Médoc. The notes of the wine are blackberry, a touch of tar and pencil box, later displays of Indian ink, and cedar wood.

Pv12 Nuits-St-Georges Cuvee VV Bertrand Ambroise 2011

Maison Ambroise dates to the 18th century and is certified organic since 2013. Only few parcels had been planted around Nuits-Saint-Georges. The wine displays wonderful dark red fruit aromas, earth, and savoury tobacco notes. *Type: Light-bodied* Grape: Pinot Noir

Pv11 Charmes-Chambertin Grand Cru Dom. Arlaud 2016

The wine is produced from two vineyard parcels in the Mazoyères climate, it has been produced using organic methods and biodynamic techniques. Aromas of red berries, cherry, and vanilla, palate is powerful, sublime finish. **Type:** Light-bodied Grape: Pinot Noir

Pv12 Morey St Denis 'Clos des Rosiers' Dom. Chantal Remy 2014

The aroma is rich with organic fruit notes, including raspberries, boysenberries, and various cherries. It also has a touch of minerality, and the texture is supple with a spicy finish. Type: Light-bodied Grape: Pinot Noir

Pv10 Marsannay 'Les Grasses Têtes' Bruno Clair 2018

The wine has a deep purple robe which goes with the weight of clay, earthy barnyard nose with rustic red berries, rustic raspberry with a prickly texture, dark plum, acidity, and resiny and stemmy notes. **Type:** Light-bodied Grape: Pinot Noir

France - Burgundy White

436 Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Cru 'Morgeot' Thomas Morey 2019 £220 'Morgeot' is cumulatively the largest premier cru vineyard in Chassagne-Montrachet. The palate is aromatic, and it reveals notes of Blossom, honey, passion fruit, apple, floral, toast and lemon peel making the wine complex and buttery.

Type: Medium to full-bodied

436B Chassagne-Montrachet Simon Colin 2019

A very pretty, delicate nose of juicy apricot and clementine. A light floury taste with hints of cream, fresh butter, and elderflower. Generous orange and clementine flesh on the palate. A Nice minerality and a medium floral finish. Type: Medium to full-bodied Grape: Chardonnay

Fr2 Puligny Montrachet Domaine Terre de Velle 2016


Is known for its purity and aromatic expression. On the nose, it opens with white flowers followed by citrus fruits. *The palate is marked by a tight structure, offering depth and length.* **Type:** Full-bodied

433 Meursault 1er Cru 'Perriere' Balot-Millot 2018

'Perrières' is a Premier cru at the southern end of Meursault. The palate has a flinty texture and great minerality It is fully expressed after opening, straightforward mid-palate with a well-rounded finish. Type: Medium to full-bodied

434 Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Cru 'Champs gains' Paul Pillot 2019 'Les Champs-Gains' is a creamy wine from Côte de Beaune. It aged for at least 12 months in oak barrels. Aromas of

white flowers, crisp green apples, beeswax, and fresh bread. Type: Medium to full-bodied Grape: Chardonnay

Pv14 Château Neuf du Pape Xavier Vignon 1972

The nose reveals stones, flint, hint of gunpowder. On the palate, expect strawberry, leather, and gardener's lime. intriguing notes of rhubarb, sage, mushrooms, and even a touch of smoke like a lit match emerge.

Pv19 Octavius Amarone Della Valpolicella Riserva Fumanelli 2017 £235

A limited-edition wine, the grapes are left to dry for 120 days to concentrate the flavours, then aged in French oak barrels for 2 years. Powerful yet elegant with wild cherry, sweet vanilla, nutmeg, mocha. **Type:** Full-bodied Grape: Blend of Corvina, Corvinone and Rondinella

Pv17 Ornellaia, Tenuta dell 'Ornellaia 2018

Pure, rich, and seductive with a smoky character. A wine which is structured yet soft, powerful but finessed. Full of flavour with notes of leather, vanilla bean, raspberry, and red cherry. **Type:** Full-bodied

Grape: Blend Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Cabernet Franc

Pv18 Corbaia Castello di Bossi 2016

The nose is elegant and complex, with notes of liquorice, prune, charred wood, iodine, and eucalyptus. The palate is juicy, with firm tannins, and is concentrated and punchy, leading to an exceptionally long finish. **Type:** Full-bodied Grape: Sangiovese & Cabernet Sauvignon

Pv19 Barbaresco 'Serracapelli' Dedicato a Paolo Dom. Cecilia Monte 2015 £200On the palate, it is surprisingly elegant, the flavors are dominated by cranberry fruit and leather, with grippy tannins quickly asserting themselves. The finish is fresh, acid-inflected, and very long, leaving the tongue tingling. **Type:** Full-bodied Grape: Nebbiolo

Portugal & Spain

Pv20 Gran Arzuaga Bodega Arzuaga 2015

This wine of iconic status is only made in selective years when the quality is thought to be on another level. Complex, with primary aromas of red fruit, herbaceous and floral scents make the wine silky and creamy in the mouth. **Type:** Full-bodied Grape: Blend of Tempranillo Cabernet Sauvignon and Albillo

Australia

Pv23 Giaconda Estate Shiraz 2019

Giaconda Vineyard and Winery is in Victoria's Beechworth. The wine has notes of damp forest floor combine with campfire smoke, raspberry, and star anise, with a satisfying fruit-laden palate of wild berries coming to the fore. Type: Full-bodied Grape: Shiraz

The wine embodies Moet & Chandon's unique style, distinguished by a bright fruitiness and elegant maturity. White fruit notes shine through including pear, peach, and apples. 182 Brut Laurent Perrier

506 Brut Pol Roger

The favoured Champagne of Winston Churchill has a beautiful golden straw-coloured hue, as well as an abundance of fine bubbles. A family run Champagne house known for its fresh and light Chardonnay dominant styles. The bubbles are fine. The nose is incredibly open and expressive and delivers aromas of peach, brioche, and vanilla. *Type: Brut 8.75 gr/litre* Grape: Blend of 40% Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and 60% Pinot Meunier

507 Grande Cuvee 166 Krug

Grande Cuvée is born from the dream of Joseph Krug to craft the absolute best Champagne he could offer, every single year. A light golden colour and fine, aromas of flowers in bloom, as well as marzipan and gingerbread. *Type: Brut 5 gr/litre* Grape: Blend of 45% Pinot Noir, 39% Chardonnay and 16% Meunier

513 Louis Roederer 2013

Powerful and complex on the palate, revealing a mixture of yellow fruit, citrus peel, and finely roasted nuts. The wine has a chalking, elegant feel. 2013 has produced the most classic, quality champagnes. *Type: Brut 9 gr/litre* Grape: Blend 60% Pinot Noir 40% Chardonnay

513 Moët & Chandon 2013

has a light golden yellow colour with fine persistent bubbles. Immediately apparent with autumnal notes of roasted chestnuts, toasted buckwheat, rich nuts, honey, and nougat. Our House's most famous wine was created in 1876 to satisfy the demanding tastes of Tsar Alexander II. Rich and complex aromas with notes of zesty and candied fruit mingled with pollen, roasted hazelnut, and Madagascar vanilla.

523 Cristal Louis Roederer Late Release 2006

517 Krug 2004

528 Belle Epoque Rose Perrier-Jouet 2010

Subtle and pure with six years ageing in the cellars. This lovely champagne developed bright bubbles, with floral notes of orange blossom, along with grapefruit, strawberries, raspberries, and warm brioche.

524 Brut Extra NV Crémant d'Alsace Meyer Fonne

A traditional method wine from the Alsace region of France, which is a wonderful alternative to Champagne. Pale lemon colour with fast small bubbles. Key notes of apples and pears, a medium acidity and very dry on the palate. *Type: Brut 5 qr/litre* Grape: 60% Pinot Auxerrois, 20% Chardonnay 15% Pinot Blanc & 5% Pinot Noir

524 Brut Extra NV Crémant de Bourgogne Domaine de la Verpaille £66 Nose of mushroom, green apple, herbal notes, elegant bubbles and developed notes of brioche and toffee. It is a nice and fresh alternative to Champagne.

520 Brut Prosecco Riflessi Masottino NV

525 Gusbourne Brut 2019

The estates first vines were planted in 2004 in the Kentish countryside. It has a bright gold colour and aromas of red fruit, cherries, and cinnamon. The palate is clean and fresh, with notes of citrus and stone fruits.




